Like this:

- On the bottom right section, write or draw something you dislike very much (ex. Spiders, asparagus, getting sick from eating too much everlasting gobstoppers, etc.)
- If you still have time, please continue: turn your postcard over.
- Write on the top: "Dear teacher,"
- Underneath, finish this sentence: "This summer I...."

- Sign your name at the bottom.
